



## RULES FOR MIXED SOCIAL BASKETBALL (Revised 27/10/2006)

1. At the start of the game a team must be represented by at least 2 female and 2 male players on the court. The fifth player can be either male or female.
2. 4 players may start the game (2 females & 2 males).
3. No more than 3 players of either sex may be on the court at any one time.
4. Normal rules of forfeiture apply.
5. If prior to the commencement of the game, a team cannot field the required players, normal late start penalties are to be applied. If after 10 minutes has elapsed a team is still unable to fulfill this requirement then normal walkover penalties are to be applied.
6. **FEMALE** players ONLY are allowed access in the restricted (key) area at EITHER END of the court . PENALTY : Violation side ball to the opposing team
7. Any intentional defensive key violation by players is to be treated as goal tending; ie. automatic 2 points to the opposing team.
8. After the first warning by the referee further intentional infringements of the above rule be penalised by a technical foul (for unsportsmanlike conduct) on the offending player.
9. Player fouls - Male players and Female players are allowed only 5 fouls.
10. 10 point rule - No player is allowed to score more than 10 points.
11. When all players left in the game and registered on the scoresheet have scored 10 points, then all players are allowed to score a further 4 points, and a team score may advance in increments of 4 points per player until time.
12. Prior to all scoring 10 points the following will apply:
13. If a player on 9 points scores a field goal, only 1 point is allowed.
14. If a player on 10 points is intentionally fouled he or she may nominate another player in their team to take the free shots (points count).
15. If a player on 10 points shoots and the basket is good, then VIOLATION, NO SCORE and side ball to the opposition is the result.
16. The above applies also to players on 3 or 4 points in the increment situation.
17. Unduly rough play will not be condoned, nor will rude or obscene language.
18. All other rules of basketball will apply.

## Rules for SUNDAY MIXED SOCIAL BASKETBALL only (Revised 24/11/2006)

1. At the start of the game a team must be represented by at least 2 female and 2 male players on the court. The fifth player can be either male or female.
2. 4 players may start the game (2 females & 2 males).
3. No more than 3 players of either sex may be on the court at any one time.
4. Normal rules of forfeiture apply.
5. If prior to the commencement of the game, a team cannot field the required players, normal late start penalties are to be applied. If after 10 minutes has elapsed a team is still unable to fulfill this requirement then normal walkover penalties are to be applied.
6. MALE players **AND** FEMALE players shall alternate halves to allow access in the restricted (key) area at EITHER END of the court. PENALTY : Violation side ball to the opposing team
7. Any intentional defensive key violation by players is to be treated as goal tending; ie. automatic 2 points to the opposing team.
8. After the first warning by the referee further intentional infringements of the above rule be penalised by a technical foul (for unsportsmanlike conduct) on the offending player.
9. Player fouls - Male players and Female players are allowed only 5 fouls.
10. 10 point rule - No player is allowed to score more than 10 points.  
When all players left in the game and registered on the scoresheet have scored 10 points, then all players are allowed to score a further 4 points, and a team score may advance in increments of 4 points per player until time.
11. Prior to all scoring 10 points the following will apply:
12. If a player on 9 points scores a field goal, only 1 point is allowed.
13. If a player on 10 points is intentionally fouled he or she may nominate another player in their team to take the free shots (points count).
14. If a player on 10 points shoots and the basket is good, then VIOLATION, NO SCORE and side ball to the opposition is the result.
